**Subject: Revision to Ease of Travel Restriction Circular No: 88-PS/CIR/2021/31**

Dear Sir/Madam,

Reference is made to our **Circular No: 88-PS/CIR/2021/31** dated **16th April 2021**.

Please be informed that the statement regarding the “two doses of a Covid-19 vaccine recognized by the World Health Organization (WHO)” in the aforementioned circular has been amended as follows.

“Completion of 14 (fourteen) days after the second dose or the prescribed dose(s) of a vaccine that has been approved by the World Health Organization, Emergency Use Listing (EUL) or the Maldives Food and Drug Authority, or any other competent authority of the respective countries.”

For more details, please refer to Air Transport Circular No: AT 14/2020 – Issue 08 issued on 18<sup>th</sup> April 2021 (Precautionary Measures Against Novel Coronavirus – Covid 19).

We anticipate your full support in this regard and request all tourist facilities to maintain adherence to the procedures and guidelines announced by the Ministry and Health Protection Agency.
